

Managers and Coaches Information

ARRIVAL

- Entry to the pool will be available from 10am.
- Please note due to numbers (200 swimmers) we are moving the warm up to start at 11am rather than 11.15am (further details below).

FINISH TIME

- We are expecting a finish time of approximately 5.20pm.

SEATING

- There will be allocated seating for Swimmers, Team Managers and Coaches, please check this as you arrive (tiered seating, picnic area on far side of learner pool) - no spectators.
- Seating for spectators will be very limited, we suggest bringing a chair.
- 1-10 swimmers = 2 coaches/TM
- 11-20 swimmers = 3 coaches/TM
- 21-30 swimmers = 4 coaches/TM
- 30 + swimmers = 5 coaches/TM

WITHDRAWALS

- Withdrawals to be posted at race control by 11.30am, to ensure a timely start.

WARM UP PROCEDURE

- We are opening warm up earlier at 11am due to numbers.
- 13 years and over - Warm up from 11.00am to 11.20am.
- 12 years and under - Warm up from 11.20am to 11.40am.
- Anyone swimming Event 1 (200 Freestyle) is welcome to join the first session.
- **LANE 6** reserved for Junior swimmers 10 and under and Para swimmers.
- Sprint dive lanes will be available for 10 min prior to the end of warm up.

RACE TIME

- This event is marshalled – please send swimmers to the marshalling area as the event is indicated on the marshalling board.
- The pool will be cleared after each race. Please remind all swimmers to exit from the sides of the pool after their race.
- We will have a dedicated marshall to escort swimmers to the start.

OFFICIALS BREAK

- There will be a 30 minute officials lunch break immediately after event 6 (approximately 1.30pm)
- There will be a 10 minute officials break immediately after event 11 (approximately 3.30pm)

RESULTS

- Results will be posted poolside as soon as possible after DQs are processed for that event.
- The age group ribbons will be decided through standard point allocations based on placings for each swimmer over a max of 5 events.
- Swimmers who swam in a 100/200m race where ribbons are not in age groups will have their points adjusted to reflect their swim within their age group.
- In the event of a tie, the ribbon will go to the swimmer with the most FINA points over their 5 swims.

SPOT PRIZES

- Swimmers' names will be called out in batches during the meet to collect a spot prize.
- Swimmers must attend the meet to receive a spot prize.

PHOTOGRAPHY

- Ice Breaker Aquatics reserves the right to photograph swimmers by a photographer engaged by the club. The collection and use of images of a swimmer may be used for promotional and public relations purposes after the event and may be shared externally with Sponsors and Partners of the Blue Ribbon Carnival.
