# SWIMMING MANAWATU OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS 2023 MEET CONDITIONS



- Entry via the SNZ Database, closing date for entries is 10:00pm 5 March 2023.
- Age as at first day of the meet.
- Entry fees \$8.50 per event. Payment is to be made through the SNZ database at the time of entry. \$1.00 from each entry fee will go to the Hokowhitu Fund.
- Pool will be open from 8.15am and 1.45pm spectators free.
- Sprint lanes one lane all warm up.
- No water is available for warm up or warm down during the sessions.
- 1500m, 800m and 400m events plus the 200m Butterfly all have a qualifying time:

- All events, except for the 50m Freestyle events, will be swum as Timed Finals.
- SNZ Policy 008 will apply. Scratchings from all events, excluding the 50m Freestyle heats, must be received before the conclusion of the preceding session. For the 800m and 1500m scratchings must be received Thursday night. The scratching penalty fee is \$50.00. The protest fee is \$100.00.
- Refunds will be made up to 7 March 2023, thereafter on production of a medical certificate presented on the day.
- Swimming Manawatu reserves the right to alter the programme and limit entries should the need arise.
- Times are required in the SNZ database for all events NT's will not be accepted. Swimmers will be removed from events for which they do not have times.

- An official's break may be held halfway through each session.
- Medals will be awarded for first, second and third places. A same gender representative may stand in to collect a medal if the recipient is unavailable. Medals may be collected prior to the presentation time if the swimmer is leaving the complex. If there is no swimmer or representative at hand the medal will not be presented.
- Manawatu trophies awarded: 50m female and male cups; Harkess Cup Premier Club; Rush Cup; Hodges Cup.
- Please note: results for 100m events will be published in the following age groups 10 years and under, 11-12 years, 13-14 years, 15 years and over, and Open age group for Multi-class swimmers (Open Multi-class).
- Time trials (\$20.00 fee) may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Secretary but only if lane space is available heats will not be reseeded. Applications will be accepted on a first in basis.
- Meet conducted under World Aquatics, SNZ & Para rules.
- All participants must agree to comply with the sports anti-doping rules.
- An official photographer may be present at the event.
