It gives me great pleasure to present the 101^h Annual Report for Swimming Manawatu Incorporated on behalf of the Governance Board.

It has been another strong year for competitive swimmers with increased numbers attending all our locally and regionally run meets. Along with swimmer and technical official attendance at national and international meets, it is particularly pleasing to see the growth with our younger swimmers and the increased number who qualified for the Junior Festival. I would like to thank all the swimmers, coaches, volunteers and families for all your hard work and passion that makes this possible.

Swimming Manawatu is in good financial shape. We have again meet all its key performance indicators (KPIs) as outlined in our vision, mission and statement of Intent. We have extended our financial support for our swimmers competing at International meets to include support for our technical officials selected for International meets. Technical officials are volunteers who have to completely self-fund to attend these meets and are selected by SNZ and FINA.

We were very fortunate to have Professor Sarah Leberman, Chair in Leadership at Massey University and well-known sports leadership expert, discuss with the Board and Management committee how we could retain our older swimmers within the sport of competitive swimming so we look forward to the first brain-storming workshop with our members who have left school. This will be followed by a workshop with our teenage members. So look out for these workshops and we are excited to see what leadership opportunities develop.

People may have read in the recent media about renewed emphasis by national sporting bodies and Sports NZ on fun and enjoyment in sports and that the majority of young people engage in sports for enjoyment. Whilst this may involve winning, we know that most of our members will not go on to the Olympics or even compete at a national level so I challenge us all to think about we can all increase the enjoyment value of competitive swimming – at a club, regional and national level. I welcome ideas from you.

The Board has several members who, over the next couple of years, will stand down at the end of their current terms of office and are not eligible for re-election as they will have serviced out their 3 terms of office as per the Constitution. I encourage you to think about putting your hand up for the job. An gentle introduction is to join the Management or Events committees, just ask any of the existing Board or Management committee members.

Congratulations to Luan Grobbelaar for his selection to the New Zealand Junior World Championship team. Congratulations also to Paris Cutler and Luan Grobbelaar who have been selected for Swimming NZ training camps.

DASC Presidents Report 2018/19



The 2018/19 year has been very positive for the Club. The most exciting development has been the resurgence of the club in its home town - we have a squad up and running in Dannevirke itself for the first time in about 5 years.

Overall club numbers have increased dramatically over the past two years with a 40 member increase across all categories in 2017/18 and a further increase of about 25 members in the current year. Included in this increase are a number of new technical officials, mostly timekeepers but our IOT trainee numbers are also on the rise.

Our sincere thanks to the staff at the Lido Aquatic Centre in Palmerston North, Trust House Pool in Masterton for their continued support of our squads. It is very pleasing to note the improved relationship with the Wai Splash pool in Dannevirke this year.

Major meets entered this year included:

- 2018 NZ Short Course Championships – DASC had 4 swimmers at this event – Fernando Castellanos was our most successful with two top ten finishes. Hannah van Wijk competed in the Para events and was hugely successful also, winning 2 Silver – 400m Free and 100m Fly; and 2 Bronze medals – 50m and 100m Back.
- 2019 NZ Open Water Championships – DASC had a team of 12 swimmers attend this event, the first time we have had a significant team. The team swam the 2.5km SNZ event and the 4 x 1km relay event, as well as swimmers competing in the Epic Swim Series.
- 2019 Junior Festival – All Stars at which the club had 30 swimmers. Everyone had an awesome time and many ribbons, 80% of swims were PB's and 7 club records were broken at this event.
- 2019 NZ Division II Competition – we had 10 swimmers competing at DivII this year in Dunedin and the team were all very successful. We returned home with 2 gold and 1 bronze medal.
- 2019 NZ Age Group Championships – we had 2 swimmers at these championships who both swam well, placing in the top 20 in each of their events.
- Manawatu Age Group and Open Championships were also very successful events for us as a club this year, with big teams competing at both events. Nando Castellanos took home the Swimming Manawatu 50m Freestyle Trophy at Manawatu open Championships.
- Wellington Championships – the club has always had good representation at both the long and short course Wellington championship events – this year was no exception.
- The 2019 Winter League competition saw the club enter large groups of junior swimmers at all of these events – these are a fabulous way to encourage younger swimmers to enjoy competitive swimming. This year the club has taken top points in the league – huge congratulations to all those swimmers who participated in these events.

In the pool the Club is going from strength to strength in line with our goals for the year. During the season there were a total of 83 club records broken across all age groups, stroke disciplines and distances, this is an indication that our coaching programmes are working well.

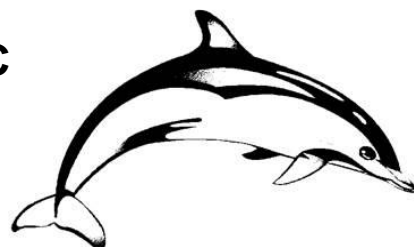

2018-19 has been a happy and successful season for FASC. Numbers in our Racing Team have remained stable, as has the base of Summer Club junior swimmers. There is a continual stream of enquiries from swimmers wishing to join FASC, and a Summer Club wait list.

SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

Huge excitement when our 13+under Boys Relay Team from 2017-18 was presented with the Foxton Cup at the beginning of the season. FASC had not won this trophy for MANY years. Hence swimmers have been very keen to compete at Winter League this year, and FASC is sitting 3rd in the competition at 30 June.

Strong improvement by all Racing Swimmers, shown by the number of “personal best” ribbons given out at Race Meets, and continually being re-ordered! 288 New Club Records were set at Meets during the Season, and 22 Medals came home from Manawatu Age Group Championships.

13 Swimmers qualified for and attended NZ Junior Festival as Manawatu Reps. 13 Top 10 placings were achieved. Team members Annika-Rose Bussel, Ryan Bussel, Duncan Clark, Rebecca Clark, Dean Coplestone, Rebekah Cudby, Daniel Gainey, Alexis Gray, Cobe Kaiuha, Tegan Murray, Zack Richards, Jack Rowe and Sam Rowe had a fantastic time and were great ambassadors for FASC. Thanks to Carla Sheridan our Grants Officer for securing funds to pay entry fees.

Sam Sheridan and Meagan Karatea qualified for and competed at North Island Secondary Schools Champs. We hope to have many more swimmers compete in future years. Meagan Karatea, Andrew Karatea and Lleyton Rasmussen qualified for Division II, but did not attend.

In November we hosted our first FASC Swimming NZ Carnival for many years. It was very successful and there was excellent feedback. A big thank you to all the clubs that supported us, and we look forward to seeing everyone again this year on 17 November.

FASC now has a strong base of qualified Time Keepers and two IOT's. Some are training for higher Officials' qualifications. Thank you to Stan Karatea and Geoff Coplestone for leading this area of our club.

TRADITIONS MAINTAINED

In a Swimming Club that has been around since 1908 there are traditions we maintain:

Our Summer Club Prizegiving at end of Term 1 was popular and enjoyed by all. The number of Trophies is now up to 27, with some exciting new ones generously donated this year.

In March we hosted the annual 'Frank Penhey Memorial Trophy' Inter-School Swimming Carnival. This has been run by FASC since 1940, and all 23 Primary and Intermediate Schools in Manawatu District are invited to attend. Some of the trophies are nearly 100 years old. It is always exciting to see so many of our swimmers competing for their schools, and to see the Senior Racing Team Members acting as IOT's and Marshals.

MODERN INNOVATIONS

In December we had our first FASC run swim camp and it was very successful. Swimmers are already booked for the next one.

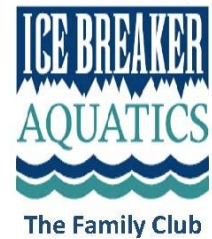
A very professional looking Newsletter was started by Rochelle Chase, and this has proven to be excellent for keeping members and other interested people in the community up-to-date with happenings at the club.

All of this has created opportunities and we continue to work to develop and implement the policies and strategies that will cater for the coaching and development of all our swimmers as we head into the future.

I would like to acknowledge our long standing head coach Darryl Gledhill for all his work over the past year. Your countless hours at the pool deck is invaluable. I'd also like to mention our Senior coach Lander Sanisitou for helping develop our senior swim team which has ballooned in size over the past year. And a special mention to our awesome coaches Emma Mortiboy, Annette Thomson and Elena Forlong and the recently departed Kelly Tissink and Madi Keightly- thank you for being part of our coaching team. Also a special mention to Eddie McKay and Niki Glintmeyer and all others that helped out during the year. To all our coaches, thank you for all the hours at trainings and turning up to carnivals to support our swimmers. You are all so highly regarded by swimmers and parents in the Club - we are so grateful to have you as part of our team.

I would also like to acknowledge Life Member Jenny O'Donnell who has stepped down from her technical officials role after many years of service to the swimming community. Jenny, we would like to thank you and we are grateful for the untold hours you have dedicated to the sport. Enjoy your retirement.

During the past year the Club undertook a review of our previous carnivals and the decision was made to revamp what we were doing in this area. This saw the inaugural running of the Blue Ribbon Carnival in November where over 200 swimmers competed. In April, we hosted our first Autumn Festival which had 157 swimmers attend. We are incredibly grateful to have both Inspire Net and DCPower Batteries come on board with generous naming rights sponsorship of these carnivals. We are also thankful to all of our sponsors of spot prizes and goodie bag items for our carnivals. These successful carnivals were a big undertaking and planning is well underway for this year's Blue Ribbon Carnival.

We had 17 swimmers attend NZ Festival Allstars in February and four swimmers attend NAGS in Wellington in April. Congratulations to Abigail Thompson who achieved silver in the 50 and 100 Breast and bronze in the 200 Breast, and Alex Odom who achieved bronze in the 50 Fly and 50 Back. Chris Arbuthnott attended the NZ Opens in June and won Gold in the 50 Fly Multi Class, 100 Fly Multi Class and silver in the 50 Free Multi class. We continue to watch and support Chris as he progresses in the sport.

A highlight of the past year was the amount of Club records that were broken by our swimmers, with some records broken by big margins. I'd like to congratulate Milan Glintmeyer, who broke seven Manawatu Records over the past year, some of these have stood for over 15 years. Congratulations to all our swimmers who broke records during the year, whether it be Manawatu, Club or even Personal Bests - it's great to see you all achieving.

Next year is a big year for the Club with it being our 25th Anniversary and we are in the early stages of planning festivities for this milestone. A focus in this next year will be the continued growth of the Club, not only on swimmers numbers, but in growth of our competitive swimmer numbers and personal development of all of our swimmers.

Thanks again to our Club executive and to those who will guide our Club forward into the next year - coaches, life members, club sponsors, all those that volunteer at any level in the club, and last but not least, thank you to all our members and our swimmers for being part of the "Family Club".

President's Report 1 July 2018 - 30 June 2019



Once again the last year has been a very busy and successful season for KiwiWest Aquatics Swim Club. We have had many new swimmers join the club and this is especially evident with a growing number of junior swimmers. We have had strong teams entering local and national meets with many personal bests, medals and records broken. A huge congratulations to all swimmers on their wonderful performances.

We had many swimmers represent our club at national meets with the club paying \$3500 in national entry fees. We spent almost \$6000 in costs for the coach to attend these meets. These consisted of NZ Short Course in Auckland in October, SNZ Junior Meet in Wellington in February, Div II in Dunedin in February, NZ NAGS in Wellington in April, and NZ Opens in Auckland in June. At these meets a number of personal bests and medals were won. The outstanding performance of Luan Grobbelaar at NAGS secured him times and a place in the New Zealand team travelling to Junior World Champs in Hungary 20-25 August. Coach Andrew was named as the head coach for this trip so we look forward to hearing results soon.

The club held its annual carnivals, Kiwi Cash Meet in July and Kiwi Junior Carnival in November. Both were well supported by swimmers with teams travelling from as far as Wellington to attend. These bring in income for our club especially as we received grants to pay for some costs. Being a large club it is great that we can run our meets entirely through our member base - no other club in the Manawatu is this strong with officials and volunteers.

For the first time in years we did not tender to distribute phone books for Yellow in May following an exorbitant amount of organisation by only a few committee members the previous year. We did hold a very successful Christmas Barn evening in November which was well supported and good income for relatively little work. We intend to do likewise in the coming year. We also provided a barbecue at the North Island Secondary Schools event at Freyberg in May. Without the phone book fundraiser that brought in almost \$10000 annually there is a huge gap in our club income going forward so the committee is keen to try new ideas and would especially like support from club members and their families with this.

In November the club organised an overnight junior camp to Marton for swimmers 12 years and under, the first to be run in many years. The swimmers swam, ate, went eeling and slept (or didn't as the case may have been) poolside. This was great fun and its success and support has enabled another junior camp to be planned for Whanganui in the July school holidays.

In December a small group of swimmers went to Australia for the Victoria State Champs and then in January our annual senior swim camp was held, returning again to AUT Millennium in Auckland. A fun time was had by all with some great swimming training and bonding taking place.

The club has been fortunate in acquiring new equipment over the last year thanks to successful grant applications. As a result we now own backstroke wedges, a water fountain has been installed and new lane ropes are on their way. Grants have also supported swimmers to attend national meets, our pool hire with Nicholls, camps and pay for pool hire at carnivals.

Club spirit is encouraged through termly club nights which end with pizza or a sausage sizzle. We held our annual prize giving in September with a dinner at China Town - fabulous for swimmers with an all you can eat buffet - and enjoyed a Christmas fun evening BBQ at the pool.

A huge thanks go to our coaches - Andrew, Trevor, Hassan and Rebecca for all their expertise, dedication and the friendly and fun approach they have to improving the performance of KiwiWest swimmers. Special thanks must also go to Jessie who has been team manager at both the junior and senior camps.

With no swimmers currently at KiwiWest and having served over 4 years on the committee it is time for me to move aside for others with fresh eyes to join. I would like to personally thank all members of the committee for their support, hard work and time commitment to meetings and organisation over this year but also over the previous years I have been on the committee. This club would not be in its current healthy state without the unpaid work of all the volunteers so thank you.

To all swimmers and families thank you for choosing to be members of KiwiWest, the premier swim club of the Manawatu. I wish the incoming committee all the best and look forward to hearing of the many future successes of KiwiWest swimmers.

The Club was represented at the Junior Festival in Wellington by twelve swimmers who all embraced the atmosphere this meet generates and produced excellent swims. Drew Bishop, Stevye Bishop and Ian Tsui all achieved top ten placings in several events. Every swimmer who attended the festival attained several personal best times – well done to you all.

Division II was held in Dunedin this year and was attended by four Club swimmers – Ashton Apperley, Stevye Bishop, Campbell Jackson and Stanley Jackson. Once again each swimmer set multi personal best times.

Six of our Club swimmers travelled to Tauranga for the increasingly popular AIMS Games. Once again they all set new personal bests.

The New Zealand Secondary School Championships, which were held in Wellington this season, attracted entries from three of our swimmers. Again all three achieved at least one personal best.

The Club was not represented at either of the National Age Group or New Zealand Open Championship events.

During the year Tony Farmer reduced the nights he was coaching to four – Tuesday to Friday. Paul Plieger has taken over training the senior swimmers and from all reports the seniors are relishing the change and the new ideas. Unity Hope has continued to coach the improver swimmers, with Ali McClenaghan teaching the new swimmers at 6pm. On behalf of the committee and all the swimmers a huge thank you to you all for all the time you put into developing the Club swimmers.

The Club held two very successful carnivals throughout the year and has managed to maintain the challenge we have set ourselves of having a small spot prize for each swimmer who attends. We continue to easily meet the minimum requirements for the required number of technical officials, however many of these come from outside our Club. I urge all families who have a swimmer competing to firstly qualify as a timekeeper, and then seriously consider training as an IOT. Officials are a critical component of the sport ensuring that racing is fair and equitable.

I was away in China at the World short course championships for the Club Christmas breakup but word quickly filtered back that it was the best yet, many thanks to Club Captains Kate Holmes and Campbell Jackson for their organisation of the event. Thanks also for their contribution round the committee table.

I would like to thank all the committee for their commitment to the Club this season. While several are considering their future availability Fiona van den Brink has decided that after many years it is time to retire as Club Treasurer. On behalf of us all, I would like to thank Fiona for all the time she has spent on Club business, keeping the books and preparing the monthly reports for the committee meetings.

I wish the incoming committee every success as they work through the challenges of the next few months and urge all swimmers to attend training regularly; it is the best way to keep your coaches motivated.

As a result of this he has been selected for the bronze NZ training squad and will benefit from camps and training at the national level.

Also in the medals at NAGS was Jack Robertson who won bronze in the 13 year olds 200 free along with the other NAGS and NZ Short Course swimmers which included Shannon Schimanski, Cayden Earles, Cheyenne Nightingale, Amelia Cronin, Lucy Somerville and Georgia Abraham, all of whom raced well.

The other and most recent highlight was Cayden and Ethan receiving RAGE (Recognition of Age Group Excellence) awards from Swimming Manawatu which is awarded to one male and one female in each age group.

Finally as we move towards another year I look forward to bringing swim meets back to Whanganui and working with the Board and Richard to make 2020 as successful as this last season


