It gives me great pleasure to present the 102<sup>nd</sup> Annual Report for Swimming Manawatu Incorporated on behalf of the Governance Board.

It has been a challenging year for everyone due to the arrival of the Covid-19 pandemic and New Zealand moving into Alert 4 on 25<sup>th</sup> March with cancellation of all swim meets and pool training. We did not move to Alert level 1 until 8 June. Limited pool training became possible from 14 May (at Alert level 2) but swim meets could not be held until level 1 was declared due to the restriction on numbers in a venue and physical distancing requirements. In reality this meant that the competitive swim year finished in March.

Prior to this, the swim year had started well with increased numbers attending all our locally and regionally run meets and it looked promising for another strong year for our swimmers. The junior festival was a great success and even more importantly our junior swimmers had great fun at the festival. Having fun at swim meets is the best way to continue with competitive swimming.

Unfortunately Alert level 4 caused significant problems for the senior meets with the cancellation of Div II and NAGS, and ultimately also the cancellation of the pinnacle NZ swim meet, the NZ Open Championship. In addition, all international FINA events and the Olympics were cancelled or postponed until next year. This created an uncertain time for our top flight swimmers. I would like to thank all the swimmers, coaches, volunteers and families for all your hard work, passion and innovative ways developed and adopted to keep our swimmers engaged and fit during the time when pool access was not possible.

Once the pools reopened it was heartening to see the number of swimmers enthusiastically returning to training and complying with the physical distancing and public health measures required. The ability to restart pool training was useful not just for swim fitness but also for the psychological health of our swimmers especially as the ability to hold competitive swim meets was very uncertain.

Swimming Manawatu would like to congratulate Luan Grobbelaar on being selected to the New Zealand Junior Swimming Team to compete in the Junior World Championships in Budapest, Hungary, 20 - 25 August 2019. Congratulations also to Luan's coach, Andrew Nichols, for being appointed as the Head Coach for the New Zealand Team.

Swimming Manawatu is in good financial shape. We were able to weather the financial impact of Covid-19 primarily as we are one of the few regions operated entirely by volunteers, hence we had no salaries to pay. We have again met all its key performance indicators (KPIs) as outlined in our vision, mission and statement of Intent. We have extended our financial support to include support for our technical officials attending national meets. Technical officials are volunteers who have to completely self-fund to attend these meets.

Following on from last year's focus on retaining our older swimmers within the sport of competitive swimming, a brain-storming workshop was run with our members who have left school – a group of 7 senior swimmers attended. This produced a variety of suggestions which the group subsequently presented to the Board. Unfortunately the impact of Covid-19 limited any implementation of these suggestions and also prevented the previously planned workshop with our teenage members. This will now become be a focus of the 20/21 year.

The Board has several members who, over the next couple of years, will stand down at the end of their current terms of office and are not eligible for re-election as they will have served out their 3 terms of office as per the Constitution. I encourage you to think about putting your hand up for the job and I would like to thank those people who have already done so. A gentle introduction is to join the Management or Operations committees, just ask any of the existing Board or Management committee members.

# DASC Presidents Report 2019-20



The 2019/20 year has been one of change for the Club. Notably for us, at the end of the season our Masterton squad has returned to Masterton Swimming Club and we wish them all the very best with their swimming under their new club. The Dannevirke based squad is very small, we are still working to be able to grow this activity in the town.

The single biggest factor affecting us all in 2020 has been the Global Covid-19 Pandemic. This has seen training programmes interrupted for many weeks and significant fitness level decreases across the board. Thankfully we managed to maintain a ZOOM fitness class each day for our swimmers which saw them engage in land-based activities with the assistance of our coaches and assistance from the Lido Aquatic Centre Gym staff. To those swimmers that engage with this activity and made it fun and exciting – thank you. Many others ran, cycled and exercised their way through lockdown as family bubbles and came back to the pool with enthusiasm and energy as soon as Level 2 was announced.

For us as a club the biggest thing was the development of new policies and practises for training etc in a public space ensuring the safety of our swimmers and the swimming public. Thanks to those who had input into this, we had great feedback from pool staff regarding our actions during this stressful time.

Our sincere thanks to the staff at the Lido Aquatic Centre in Palmerston North for their continued support of our squads. The team at the Lido have been fabulous in working with the squads in order to have them back in the water under the initial Alert Level 2 and subsequently. We have been incredibly lucky in New Zealand and especially in Palmerston North, to have been able to have our squads in the water at all. Our thoughts are with those who have not been so lucky – many are still unable to swim at all.

Sadly, many of our major meets this year have had to be cancelled due to the Global Covid-19 Pandemic, those that survived were:

- 2019 Wellington SC Championships – DASC had a small team at this event, the team was successful in achieving their personal swim goals. Notable performance was in the 11 year old boys age group which was dominated by Hunter Lloyd from Wellington and Brayden Bell from Dannevirke – exciting competition from these two all weekend – and again at the Junior Festival.
- 2019 NZ Short Course Championships – DASC had 2 swimmers at this event – Cameron Gillespie and Hannah Moore.
- 2020 NZ Open Water Championships – DASC had a team of 8 swimmers attend this event, the best placing for this team was Hannah Moore who placed 8<sup>th</sup> in the 18 & over 2500m. DASC also had a team of swimmers competing in the Epic Swim Series. We entered teams into the 4 x 100m relay also.
- 2020 Wellington LC – DASC has always had good representation at these regional championship events, this year was an exceptionally good year in this regard.
- 2020 Manawatu Age Group Championships – DASC had a large team at this event winning medals, setting PB's and competing well in the 50m environment.
- 2020 Manawatu Open Championships – DASC had a large and successful team at this event.
- 2020 All-Stars Junior Festival in March - DASC had a team of 20+ swimmers who brought home many ribbons and PB's.
- 2020 NZ Division II Competition – we had a team of 12 swimmers qualify this year, sadly this team were unable to compete due to Covid-19.
- 2020 NZ Opens and 2020 SNZ NAGS saw the club with qualifiers unable to attend these priority meets due to lockdown conditions. Significant for us was the achievement of the qualifying times – congratulations to those who did qualify.

The Club is going from strength to strength in line with our goals for the year. During the season there were a total of 114 club records broken across all age groups, stroke disciplines and distances. This is an indication that our coaching programmes are working well, and an increase of 30 on the previous year.

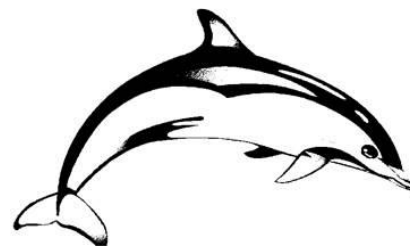
The single factor affecting our ability to grow in Palmerston North is the lack of available training space in the public access pools in the city. We will keep encouraging the City Council to remedy this situation.

Due to Covid-19, we lost our DC Power Batteries Autumn Festival that was due to be held in March this year. We thank Lander for his service and contribution to the club over the years. We are extremely fortunate that Emma accepted the position and now has command of our High performance & Fitness senior squads, under Darryl's guidance. And with Annette and Hollie in charge of our development and fundamental squads, we really are lucky to have the depth of experience that we currently have in our coaching ranks at the moment. I would also like to acknowledge Lynette Singleton who has done the most fantastic job working with our coaches, especially with the work around the restructure of our squads that was undertaken during lockdown which has been a long time in the making.

To our committee for the past year, Lynette, Michelle, Darryl, Karen, Sarah, Stacy and Michele, thank you so much for your input keeping this club going over the year. It takes a lot of energy, some robust debate and input to keeping the club moving forward. We have been extremely fortunate to have had you on board. I would like to especially acknowledge Stacy who came on board to take on our secretary role when work commitments got in the way for Sarah, and to Michele, who is stepping down after four years on committee. Thank you so much for your work Mich, you have made and will continue to make a huge contribution to the club. We are defiantly in a better place for having you on board and we thank you for your service.

Highlights for the year include Abby Thompson achieved 2 gold and a silver at NZ Secondary Schools in September 2019. She followed this up with 2 gold and a silver in the same events at NZ Short Course Champs in October. Over the course of these 2 events, Abby also set 3 Manawatu Records in 50 and 100 Breaststroke. Alex Odom achieved 2 silver and 2 bronze at NZ Secondary Schools in September 2019. Milan Gintmeyer for achieving 11 Manawatu Records in the past year and her outstanding performance at NZ Juniors - she was ranked in the Top 10 for 11 years olds in many of her NZ Juniors results. She also swam 50/100/200 butterfly events the fastest for any 11-year-old in NZ. Our 12&U 4x50 Free relay team getting 3rd at NZ Juniors. We had a team of 15 Juniors attend NZ Juniors and the Team impressed with 75 new PBs, 20 podium finishes and 38 other Top 10 finishes.

The Inspire net Blue Ribbon was again a huge success. 209 competitors packed into Freyberg for a day of racing and fun. This carnival takes a huge amount of organising, so a big thanks to those that help make this carnival what it is. The day was marked by representation from Mayor Grant Smith & Councillor Billy Meehan who attended this meet and were extremely impressed. Planning is well under way for this year's edition and fingers are crossed for another blockbuster.

Covid-19 may have put a big dent in our swimming year for what was supposed to be our celebration of our 25years, but what it could not do was put a dent in our family club culture. We continue to maintain strong numbers and will continue to build our club around our Ice Breaker Aquatics motto- The family club.

Without your efforts, commitment, dedication and willingness to support the Club, we would not be in such a fortunate position. In spite of COVID 19, we have sustained stable Club membership with some outstanding results for swimmers, whether it be in terms of personal bests, medals or in our relay teams. We have also seen our current committee and Coach work innovatively and with thoughtfulness to overcome the challenges of our new COVID environment.

We all need to continue to help our swimmers meet their personal goals, giving them responsibility and a say in the direction they want to take their swimming. However in order to do this, we need parents to step up and help, not just with committee involvement but in other essential activities that enable us to compete in events. We need to focus this year on building parents' capability to take on the necessary roles such as Official Time Keepers and Inspectorates of Turns. Should we continue to struggle to fulfil the requirements for such swim meets, we run the risk of being unable to compete.

Our junior members have grown not only in numbers but speed and skill. Whilst our senior member group is smaller, we have seen some truly outstanding achievements. Normally we would hold our prize-giving around this time but due to working through the COVID restrictions and getting our personal lives back to a new normal, we made the decision to temporarily delay this special event. Overall, the 12 years and under swim team developed well over the summer season producing an encouraging team ethic/code at NZ Junior Festival. All achieved personal goals. The whole team combined, achieved approximately 80% in Personal Bests!

To this year's committee, a big thank you! Members include Susan Angus, Club Secretary; Rene Gardiner- Hokianga, Funding Applications; Dayna Vanderwiell, Uniforms; Treena Gray and Esta Kennett, Enrolments; Leigh Howchow-Media (who has recently resigned), Social Media; Kylie Jennings, Treasurer; and Jacqui Kerins, Race Secretary. Did you know that Jacqui and Kylie have given well over seven years commitment to the Club Committee? It is now time for them to relinquish their respective roles due to the rules of the Constitution. We cannot thank both ladies enough for their dedication, responsiveness and skills to help keep the Levin Swimming Club afloat and heading in the right direction. # Kiwi West Aquatics Incorporated

## Club President's Report

### July 2019 – 30 June 2020



As usual it has been another eventful year at Kiwi West Aquatics, but not in the way we have come to expect. Significant events have marked this year as different.

First, we have seen Trevor and Margaret Nicholls retire and close the Nicholls Swim Academy business at the West End Pool. We are sad to see the end of their involvement – this is truly the end of an era for our club, but we are grateful for their contribution and dedication to swimming in our club, region and nation. As a result of this change our committee needed a new coaching arrangement and have formed a partnership with Andrew's "Nicholls International Coaching Limited" (NICL) with his team providing continuity for our swimmers and club for the new swim year.

Second, Hilton Brown Swimming agreed to take over operation of the West End Aquatic Centre from 1 July 2020 to ensure the facility continues to serve the school and local community. This is a new relationship for our club, and together with the West End School we hope to see the pool operating for many years to come.

Third, the arrival of Covid19 in 2020 resulted in a pause of swim activities, and the shutdown of pools around the country. This brought unexpected challenges for pool operators, clubs, coaches, and swimmers alike. The disruption to training, committees, fundraising, and swim competitions caused by the pandemic has been historic. I thank our members for their patience and co-operation during this difficult time, and our committee members who continued meeting via Zoom when required. Our club applied for and received some Covid19 funding for sports clubs to offset some of the financial impact we have experienced.

Our club continues to look to the future as we reflect on a challenging year. We have seen steady membership and success from junior to senior swimmers. We have entered strong teams in local and national meets with many personal bests, medals and records broken. Huge congratulations to all swimmers on their individual performances, achievements, and persistence.

This swim year KWA held our Cash Meet in July 2019 and Junior Carnival in November 2019. With our July 2020 Cash Meet being cancelled due to Covid19 restrictions we expect the next swim year may be further disrupted. Cancelled meets created extra work for our committee and resulted in some unused grant funds being returned. I thank all the KWA affiliated officials who support our club and region. We especially appreciate the contribution of those who continue to turn-out after their swimmers have retired from competition.

In August Luan Grobbelaar attended the Junior World Champs at Budapest (Hungary) with Andrew Nicholls who attended as SNZ Head Coach. He was also selected to attend the New South Wales Open Champs, and Queensland Open State Champs.

We have continued to contribute to coaches' costs to support the swimmers representing our club. Six swimmers entered one or more events at the NZ Open Water Champs in January achieving a total of six top-10 results. Eight swimmers attended SNZ Junior Festival at WRAC in February together the team set a total of 45 PBs, and 43 top-10 placings. Both Div II and NAGS were cancelled due to Covid19 restrictions.

At the 2020 Manawatu Open Champs our club again secured the Harkess Cup for the club with the most points won at Manawatu Regional Championships. The Kiwi Sports club and Kiwi West Aquatics have held this cup continuously for the last 34 years. Together our swimmers broke 40 Manawatu Records, and 1 NZ record during the 2019/20 swim year.

We held our annual prize-giving in September 2019 at the West End School hall. Club spirit has since been tested by the disruption to some of our normal habits and routines in 2020. Where possible we have continued to run club nights with events to decide club trophies and providing pizza or a sausage sizzle for the swimmers.

We continued our approach to fund-raising with our Christmas Barn evening - an effective event supported by our members. ## NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2020

### 1 **STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

These are the financial statements of Swimming Manawatu Incorporated.

Swimming Manawatu Incorporated is an Incorporated Society established under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908.

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Special Purpose Framework for us by Not-For-Profit (SPFR for NFPEs) published by Chartered Accountants Australia and New Zealand. The Financial Statements have been prepared for the society's members as a requirement of the society's Constitution.

The accounting policies adopted are not in conformity with generally accepted accounting practice. Accordingly the financial statements should only be relied on for the expressly stated purpose.

The accounting principles recognised as appropriate for the measurement and reporting of earnings and financial position on an historical cost basis have been used, with the exception of certain items for which specific accounting policies have been identified.

#### ***Property, Plant, Equipment and Depreciation***

Property, plant and equipment are included at cost less aggregate depreciation provided at the maximum rates allowed by the Inland Revenue Department. Property, plant and equipment that are leased under a finance lease for the purposes of the Income Tax Legislation are capitalised and depreciated. The depreciation rates used are shown in the Schedule of Property, Plant and Equipment.

#### ***Accounts Receivable***

Accounts receivable are stated at their estimated realisable value.

#### ***Investments***

Investments are stated at cost.

#### ***Goods and Services Tax***

Financial information in these accounts is recorded exclusive of GST with the exception of receivables and payables, which include GST. GST payable or receivable at balance date is included in the appropriate category in the Balance Sheet.

#### ***Changes in Accounting Policies***

There have been no specific changes in accounting policies and they have been applied on a consistent basis with those of the previous period.

On 28 April 2020, New Zealand went to alert level 3. On 14 May 2020, New Zealand went to alert level 2. On 9 June 2020, New Zealand went to alert level 1. At this time the full financial impact of the COVID-19 pandemic is not able to be determined however it has already impacted a number of events during this financial year causing total income to be reduced.

#### 7 **RELATED PARTIES**

There are no transactions involving related parties during the year (last year: Nil)

#### 8 **HOKOWHITU SWIMMERS FUND**

The Hokowhitu Swimmers Fund was established in 2000 when the Hokowhitu Swimming Club forwarded their remaining funds to Swimming Manawatu. Each year \$1 from every swimmer in the winter leagues is deposited into this fund and swimmers in the Manawatu Region are eligible to apply annually for funding to assist with travel to either international or national meets. In 2020 no winter leagues were held due to Covid-19. \$750 was paid to L Grobbelaar.
